\$100,000 in Scholarships Awarded by the SCCS Education Foundation

Scholarships help students attend Sandusky Central Catholic School and St. Mary Central Catholic High School. More than 600 students were enrolled for the 2017-2018 school year with the dream of getting the best education possible and doing so in an affordable Catholic learning environment. Their dreams were made possible because of you!

The SCCS Education Foundation distributed 62 scholarships totaling nearly \$100,000. Many of those scholarships were awarded to help students continue their education at SCCS, while others allowed graduating seniors to continue their education beyond high school.

In 2017, the Bastien family and friends worked with the SCCS Education Foundation to establish the Abigail M. Bastien Memorial Scholarship Fund. With more than \$25,000 in investment revenue, two scholarships (one for Perkins and one for SMCC) were established for seniors who will attend a 4-year college, participate in track and field, and have a GPA of over 3.5.

At just 19 years old, Abigail "Abby" Bastien lived her life to the fullest. A 2016 St. Mary Central Catholic High School graduate, Abby was loved and adored by so many and this scholarship reflects her passion for learning, athletics, and her faith.

Each school year, Sandusky Central Catholic School receives cards and thank you notes from students, parents, and families. These messages are filled with inspiring words of hope, faith, joy, and above all, gratitude.

All families want their children to be the best version of themselves. The gift of tuition assistance provides a "hand up" for families facing various challenges that limit their financial resources. More than 80% of families received some form of tuition assistance during the 2017-2018 school year. Donations for tuition assistance totaled \$230,000, with the SCCS Education Foundation contributing \$73,500 of that amount.

Arthur and Mildred Link Family Investing in Educators Fund (\$569,718) was established in 2017. Mr. Link loved his family and the education he received at St. Mary Central Catholic. This new fund reflects this legacy and will provide classroom enhancements, teacher incentives, and professional development funds for teachers in grades Pre-K through 8.

Investing in Educators Fund (\$30,788) was established to help SCCS recruit, retain, and support teachers. This investment fund is dedicated to help close the gap between Catholic School and public school teacher salaries.

Gallagher Family Library/Technology Fund (\$80,799) was established by Dr. James & Mrs. Michele Gallagher and Dr. Susan Gallagher. In 2017, the family amended the gift to include classroom needs related to technology. This past year, \$3,400 was made available and used for computers for classroom instruction.

To fund an Endowed Chair, donors are asked for a \$25,000 pledge paid over a five year period. As gifts are received, the principle continues to grow. The impact of donations to Investing in Educators cannot be overstated. With your help, these funds will continue to recruit, retain, and reward the very best teachers, and maintain classroom materials, educational tools, learning centers, and technology. The SCCS Education Foundation distributed just over \$116,000 to teachers in 9-12th grade.



Named Tuition Assistance Funds

Dorothy Yontz Tuition Assistance Fund (\$143,571) was established by her son Kenneth and daughter Barb Pack in memory of their mother Dorothy Yontz who attended Holy Angels School. This fund provides assistance at SCCS for Holy Angels parish families.

Sister Mary Jon Wagner Tuition Assistance Fund (\$81,303) was established in honor of SCCS’s first superintendent upon her retirement. It is used to provide general SCCS tuition assistance annually.

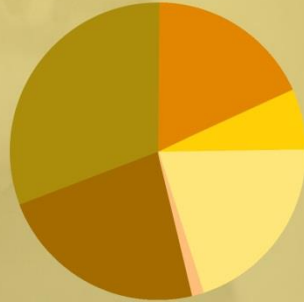

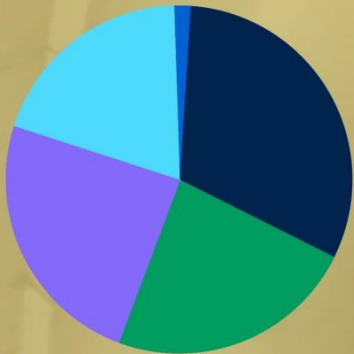

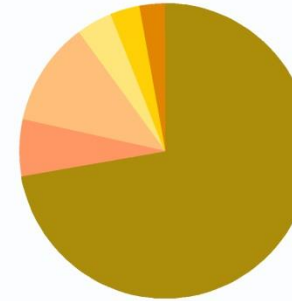
In the coming year, the SCCS Education Foundation will work to:

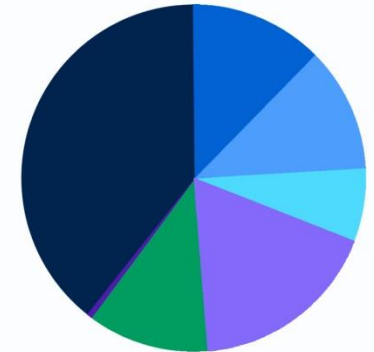
